How can the LITC help me?

- The LITC can represent you before the IRS or in US Tax Court on audits, appeals, tax collection matters, and other tax disputes. Services are provided for free or for a small fee.
- Although the LITC receives partial funding from the IRS, LITCs, its employees, and its volunteers are completely independent of the IRS.
- In order to qualify for assistance from an LITC, generally a taxpayer's income must be below a certain threshold, and the amount in dispute with the IRS is usually less than \$50,000.

Common Issues

I have been told that my tax return is being audited.

Contact us if the IRS has told you that they are looking at your income tax return or have told you that they plan on changing your tax return, increasing the tax you owe, or reducing your refund.

I owe taxes.

Contact us if you have been getting bills from the IRS and want help in finding out what your options are for paying the taxes you owe.

I overpaid my taxes and want to get a refund.

Contact us if you want to try to get back federal taxes you paid but you now wish to dispute.

I want to petition the Tax Court, I have filed a Tax Court petition, or I am scheduled for a trial at the Tax Court

We may be able to represent you before the Tax Court. If you need to file a petition or already have a trial date with the Tax Court, contact us immediately so we can see if we can help.

I have not filed my tax returns in past years.

The LITC does not prepare tax returns. However, we may be able to help you with the preparation of a return if it helps you to resolve a dispute with the IRS.

I filed my tax return, but did not get my refund.

For instance, if you filed a tax return and claimed certain deductions or credits (such as the EITC), and the IRS has not paid you your refund, contact us to see if we can help.

You may call the LITC if:

- The IRS has kept any of your refunds
- You have federal income tax liability
- · You have received a notice or letter from the IRS
- You haven't received all of your stimulus payments or advanced child tax credit payments.
